\$6,000 for the Gosford Hospital Special Care Nursery

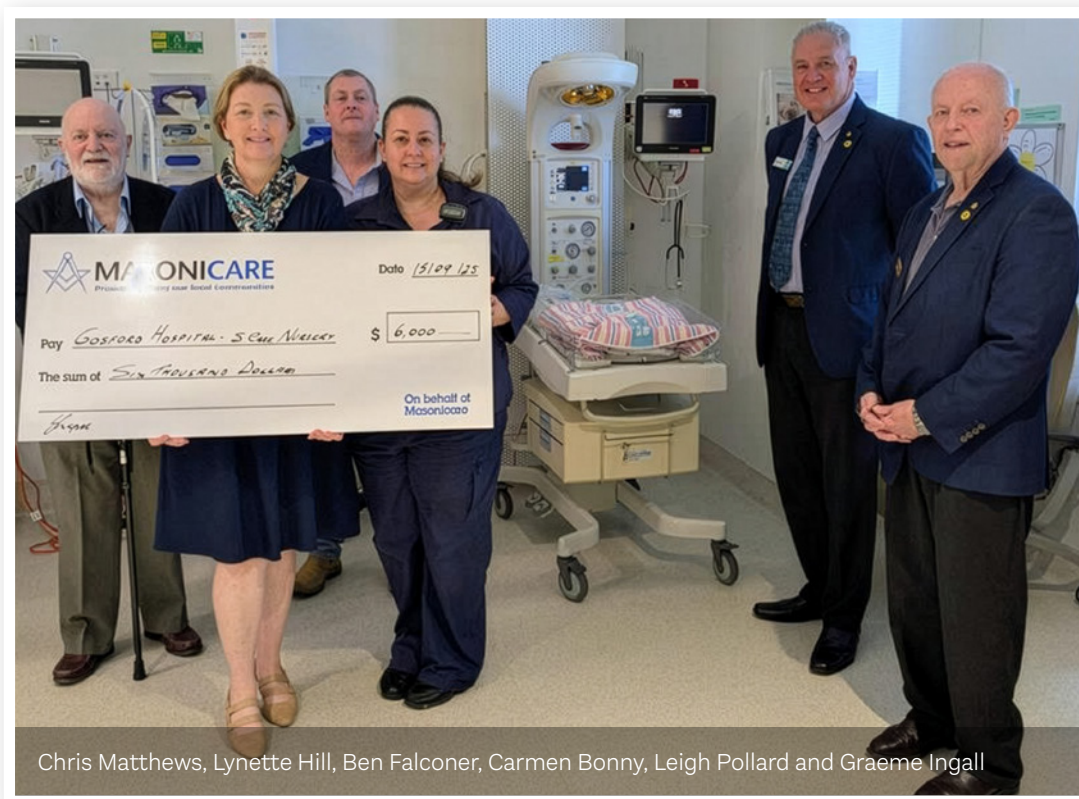

For a few months now the funds raised have been collected for the Gosford Hospital Special Care Nursery, the facility that provides care for premature and unwell babies over 32 weeks gestation, to purchase much needed equipment to help with their treatment.

A total of \$3,000 was raised which was doubled by Masonicare, the Masonic Grand Lodge Charity, and presented to Ms Carmen Bonny, Clinic Nurse Educator, and Ms Lynette Hill, Director – Women, Children and Families.

At the presentation the Freemasons were given a special tour of the nursery, which has rooms for parents who stay overnight, humidicribs of all sizes and other specialized equipment that our donation will help to provide and maintain.
